

**NAME**

rmgun -- remove group or user name

**SYNOPSIS**

```
rmgun(name,bit)
char name;
int bit;
```

**DESCRIPTION**

rmgun removes the given user (name) from the /etc/passwd file (if bit is 0) or removes the given group (name) from the /etc/group if the bit is non zero. rmgun will return:

- 0 - if it was successful.
- 1 - if it could not find the user/group in the passwd/group file.
- 2 - system problems: could not open or link passwd/group or /etc/ptmp files, or perform any of the other routine system calls.  
Close is the only sys call not checked.
- 3 - given user has a colon in name
- 4 - /etc/ptmp already exists (try again).
